OBJECTIVE

The investment policy of the portfolio shall be to track the S&P South Africa Low Volatility Index as closely as possible, by buying only constituent securities in the same weightings in which they are included in the Index and selling only securities which are excluded from the Index from time to time as a result of quarterly Index reviews or corporate actions.

The index, which is constructed and maintained by S&P Dow Jones Indices, is designed to provide exposure to the least volatile stocks on the S&P South Africa Composite Index. Volatility is measured by using the one year trailing standard deviation. The 40 least volatile stocks passing the liquidity filter are selected and are then weighted by the inverse of their volatility i.e. the company with the lowest volatility has the highest weighting and the company with the highest relative volatility has the lowest weighting.

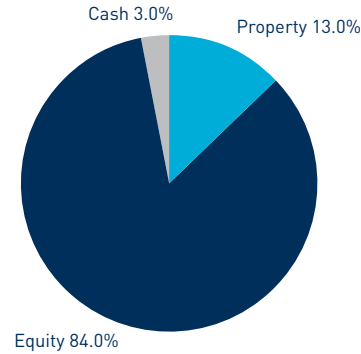
